 - a. Sponsors don't have to judge everything, they coordinate the judging
 - b. Results should be sent to Parker three weeks before State
 - 5. Early Bird Registration Deadline: March 4th
 - 6. Final Registration Deadline: March 17th
 - 7. Fall Forum checks will go to Magistra McQuaid
 - 8. Handbook Revisions:
 - a. Waiver forms must be turned in or else a student will not be able to participate
 - b. Registration Dates

i. If you don't sign up, you don't participate

- c. Level of Latin at State is same as level on NLE
- d. Scrapbook

i. Late pre-convention submission of scrapbook materials will be docked one place

- ii. If pre-convention materials are not submitted, the scrapbook will be disqualified
- e. Slogan Rubric

i. There is no rubric for slogan, the Convention Coordinators will create one

- d. Sight Latin: no translation of the Latin will be provided
- f. Essay
 - i. High School Chapters can only send 4 students, 1 per grade
 - ii. Middle School chapters can only send 4 students
- g. Costume Contest
 - i. 10 points will be deducted if you exceed \$40 limit

ii. You will be disqualified if you do not turn in receipts

h. Awards

i. Divisions will be at the discretion of the Coordinators

ii. Sweepstakes points will go to the schools with the most points

iii. Middle School divisions can fluctuate between I/m/s and I/s

i. Medals and Trophies

i. Trophies will be awarded to the top three schools of each division

ii. Schools that win the Apollo, Calliope, Minerva, Mercury also get a trophy

iii. Want to move towards medals instead of trophies

iv. Medals for academic testing will be given to the top five overall winners "Best in Show"

v. Each member of the top three Certamen teams will receive medals

vii. Top delegate in Graphic Arts, Creative Arts, Academic Testing and Olympika will receive a medal

viii. Rosettes will be awarded for Skit, Scrapbook, and Publicity

ix. Ribbons will be awarded for everything else

9. Motion made by Caris Gross to adopt the proposed handbook changes, seconded by Magister Henkel, motion passes

10. When schools submit contests entries that lead to appointed offices, they should list the person who would become the officer

a. May vote on this through a Google Form

VIII. Nationals

A. Chaperones for Nationals

1. Mrs. Niimi suggested more chaperones should be paid for. There are not enough male chaperones

a. Magister Henkel said when there is more than 12 students per chaperone the students will be chaperoned by someone from another state

IX. New Business

A. Constitution and Bylaw revisions

1. Deadline for voting was missed, so changes were discussed and will be voted on next meeting

2. Proposed changes:

a. Two minor changes in wording from his to his/her in the Constitution (Article IV, Section 3 and Article V, Section 6, Part B)

b. Change to Article V, Section 4, Part F that would remove the restrictions on how many students from a single school could run for office after the State of Emergency

c. Change to Article V, Section 5, Part A that would ban campaigning until after the General Assembly on Friday at State Convention

d. Change to Article VI that would pay the full registration for Nationals for all officers

e. Change to Article VI, Sections A, C, D that would require the President, 2nd VP, and Parliamentarian to attend Nationals. Their full packet would be paid for.

f. Change to Article VI, Sections B, E, F, G, I, J that would highly recommend but not require the 1st VP, Secretary, Torch Editor, MS Rep, Publicity Chair, and Technology Coordinator to attend Nationals. A half packet would be paid for them.

g. Change to Article VI, Section H that would provide a full packet to one Historian, even if there are Co-Historians. In the case of Co-Historians, each would receive a half packet.
